Students will create documentary-style films for a series of History Mysteries- focusing on lost and forgotten adventures that took place in downtown Jonesborough- Tennessee's oldest town. Working with historians, filmmakers, and archaeologists, students will each choose a mystery they would like to expose. They will then write, direct, shoot, act in, and edit their own film, using high-def digital editing software. Green Screen technology will also be an option, as students place characters in historical settings and exotic locales. Students will also have access to artifacts, old documents, photos and letters, and have the freedom to shoot in locations throughout town, including the historic cemetery, the Chuckey Depot, and areas that are usually closed to the public, such as the Christopher Taylor Cabin. Student films will be presented at the 6th Annual Jonesborough Student Film Festival on November 5, 6 pm.

This class will meet on Saturday, June 13th, 9 a.m. - Noon.

Class will be held at our TV Studio at the Elmer Gillespie Building at Persimmon Ridge Park. Due to various filming locations students may need to be dropped off and picked up at the International Storytelling Center on Main Street. Parents will be notified about location changes ahead time.

## Camp Information

### Regular Drop-Off and Pick-Up Times

For 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. camps drop-off your student/s no earlier than 8:45 a.m. or 12:45 p.m. For camps ending at noon or at 4:00 p.m., please pick-up your student/s at that time.

Drop-off and pick-up will happen at the back of the building. Follow signs and directions.

On the first day of camp please park and come into the building. You will get to meet the instructor(s) and see the classroom. You will receive a parking pass with your child's last name. Please have this in your dashboard in the left-hand side of your vehicle. This will help us with identifying you as an authorized person to pick-up your student. Students will not be allowed to be picked up by individuals without this parking pass. If you need an extra pass to give to a spouse, grandparent, etc., please notify us.

### First Day

On the first day of camp, please park and escort your student into the building to check in, receive a parking pass, meet the teachers and see their classroom.

### Dress Code

Please dress for mess. Closed-toed shoes are required for safety: no flip-flops or sandals. Students will also be outside for activities and for breaks. The classrooms can get chilly with air conditioning: please send a sweatshirt or sweater with your child if this will be a problem. Please bring an extra change of clothes as accidents can occur.

### Lunch and Snacks

Snacks are included in the camp registration fee. However, students are free to bring their own snacks. Snacks must be non-refrigerated and clearly labeled with your student's full name. Camp provided snacks will include items such as carrots and apples. Please, do not send snacks that contain peanuts for the safety of other campers! If students are staying at the McKinney Center the entire day, they should bring their own lunch. Lunch is held from Noon – 1:00 p.m. All campers must remain in the McKinney Center or on the grounds during lunch unless signed out by a parent or guardian.
